We have ongoing problems with ATVs and motorbikes within the park. Considerable damage has been caused by their activity. Trails have become deeply rutted causing erosion and drainage problems making hiking difficult in many areas. Hikers have also been intimidated by the divers of these vehicles.

Strong legislation is needed to stop this activity. Increased penalties both monetary and through confiscation are needed.
