**"AN ACT REQUIRING MINORS TO WEAR HELMETS IN
COMMERCIAL BASEBALL BATTING CAGES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) No person under
4 eighteen years of age may enter into a commercial, nonprofit or
5 municipally operated baseball batting cage unless such person is
6 wearing protective headgear that meets standard performance
7 specifications, as defined by the National Operating Committee on
8 Standards for Athletic Equipment.

9 (b) Failure to comply with this section shall not be a violation or an
10 offense. Failure to wear protective headgear as required by subsection
11 (a) of this section shall not be considered to be contributory negligence
12 on the part of a parent or guardian of the person under eighteen years

13 of age.

14 (c) No cause of action shall arise against, nor shall any liability be
15 imposed against any person or municipality regarding failure to
16 comply with the provisions of subsection (a) of this section."
