**"AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
FOR PERSONS EXPERIENCING A DRUG OVERDOSE."**

1 Strike lines 56 to 64, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(g) The provisions of subsections (a) to (c), inclusive, of this section
4 shall not apply to any person (1) who in good faith, seeks medical
5 assistance for another person who such person reasonably believes is
6 experiencing an overdose from the ingestion, inhalation or injection of
7 intoxicating liquor or any drug or substance, (2) for whom another
8 person, in good faith, seeks medical assistance, reasonably believing
9 such person is experiencing an overdose from the ingestion, inhalation
10 or injection of intoxicating liquor or any drug or substance, or (3) who
11 reasonably believes he or she is experiencing an overdose from the
12 ingestion, inhalation or injection of intoxicating liquor or any drug or
13 substance and, in good faith, seeks medical assistance for himself or
14 herself, if evidence of the possession or control of a controlled
15 substance in violation of subsection (a), (b) or (c) of this section was

16 obtained as a result of the seeking of such medical assistance. For the
17 purposes of this subsection, "good faith" does not include seeking
18 medical assistance during the course of the execution of an arrest
19 warrant or search warrant or a lawful search."

20 Strike lines 91 to 98, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
21 following in lieu thereof:

22 "(d) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to
23 any person (1) who in good faith, seeks medical assistance for another
24 person who such person reasonably believes is experiencing an
25 overdose from the ingestion, inhalation or injection of intoxicating
26 liquor or any drug or substance, (2) for whom another person, in good
27 faith, seeks medical assistance, reasonably believing such person is
28 experiencing an overdose from the ingestion, inhalation or injection of
29 intoxicating liquor or any drug or substance, or (3) who reasonably
30 believes he or she is experiencing an overdose from the ingestion,
31 inhalation or injection of intoxicating liquor or any drug or substance
32 and, in good faith, seeks medical assistance for himself or herself, if
33 evidence of the use or possession of drug paraphernalia in violation of
34 said subsection was obtained as a result of the seeking of such medical
35 assistance. For the purposes of this subsection, "good faith" does not
36 include seeking medical assistance during the course of the execution
37 of an arrest warrant or search warrant or a lawful search."
