- 3 section as ineligible to earn risk reduction credit, any person sentenced
- 4 for a violation of: (1) Section 53a-55a of the general statutes, concerning
- 5 manslaughter in the first degree with a firearm; (2) section 53a-59 of
- 6 the general statutes, concerning assault in the first degree; (3) section
- 7 53a-59a of the general statutes, concerning assault of an elderly, blind,
- 8 disabled, pregnant or mentally retarded person in the first degree; (4)
- 9 section 53a-59c of the general statutes, concerning assault of a pregnant
- 10 woman resulting in termination of pregnancy; (5) section 53a-70 of the

11 general statutes, concerning sexual assault in the first degree; (6)
12 section 53a-70c of the general statutes, concerning aggravated sexual
13 assault of a minor; (7) section 53a-72b of the general statutes,
14 concerning sexual assault in the third degree with a firearm; (8) section
15 53a-90a of the general statutes, concerning enticing a minor; (9) section
16 53a-92 of the general statutes, concerning kidnapping in the first
17 degree; (10) section 53a-92a of the general statutes, concerning
18 kidnapping in the first degree with a firearm; (11) section 53a-101 of
19 the general statutes, concerning burglary in the first degree; (12)
20 section 53a-111 of the general statutes, concerning arson in the first
21 degree; (13) section 53a-134 of the general statutes, concerning robbery
22 in the first degree; or (14) section 53a-196a of the general statutes,
23 concerning employing a minor in an obscene performance, shall be
24 ineligible to earn risk reduction credit under this section."
