**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET
CONCERNING GENERAL GOVERNMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
4 to study the most effective means of transitioning from the use of
5 generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP), as prescribed by the
6 Governmental Accounting Standards Board, on a modified cash basis
7 to a full accrual basis in the preparation and maintenance of the annual
8 financial statements and budget of the state.

9 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

10 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

11 (2) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

12 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
13 Representatives;

- 14 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 15 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
16 Representatives;
- 17 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 18 (7) The Treasurer, or the Treasurer's designee;
- 19 (8) The Comptroller, or the Comptroller's designee;
- 20 (9) Two persons appointed by the Governor; and
- 21 (10) The chairs and ranking members of the joint standing
22 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
23 relating to finance, revenue and bonding and appropriations and the
24 budgets of state agencies.
- 25 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
26 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
27 of the General Assembly.
- 28 (d) All appointments to the task force shall be made not later than
29 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
30 filled by the appointing authority.
- 31 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
32 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task
33 force, from among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons
34 shall schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held
35 not later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 36 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
37 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
38 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies shall serve as
39 administrative staff of the task force.
- 40 (g) Not later than July 1, 2012, the task force shall submit a report on
41 its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committees of

42 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to finance,
43 revenue and bonding and appropriations and the budgets of state
44 agencies, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
45 general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it
46 submits such report or July 1, 2012, whichever is later."
