10 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
11 internal references accordingly:

12 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the  
13 provisions of section 9-750 of the general statutes, on and after the  
14 effective date of this section, (1) no funds received by the State  
15 Treasurer under part III of chapter 32 of the general statutes and  
16 deposited in the General Fund shall be credited to the Citizens'  
17 Election Fund established in section 9-701 of the general statutes, and  
18 (2) no revenues from the tax imposed under chapter 208 of the general  
19 statutes shall be deposited in the Citizens' Election Fund.

20 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 157 of the general  
21 statutes, no grants shall be paid from the Citizens' Election Fund.

22 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
23 section 9-701 of the general statutes, on or after July 1, 2011, any funds  
24 remaining on June 30, 2011, in the Citizens' Election Fund established  
25 in section 9-701 of the general statutes shall be transferred from said  
26 fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal  
27 year ending June 30, 2012.

28 Sec. 503. Section 3-69a of the general statutes is repealed and the  
29 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

30 (a) (1) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the funds received  
31 under this part, excluding the proceeds from the sale of property  
32 deposited in the Special Abandoned Property Fund in accordance with  
33 section 3-62h, shall be deposited in the General Fund.

34 (2) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, [and each fiscal year  
35 thereafter] to the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, inclusive, a portion  
36 of the funds received under this part shall, upon deposit in the General  
37 Fund, be credited to the Citizens' Election Fund established in section  
38 9-701 as follows: (A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, seventeen  
39 million dollars, (B) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, sixteen  
40 million dollars, (C) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, seventeen

41 million three hundred thousand dollars, and (D) for the fiscal year  
42 ending June 30, 2009, [and each fiscal year thereafter] through the fiscal  
43 year ending June 30, 2011, inclusive, the amount deposited for the  
44 preceding fiscal year, adjusted in accordance with any change in the  
45 consumer price index for all urban consumers for such preceding fiscal  
46 year, as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau  
47 of Labor Statistics. The State Treasurer shall determine such adjusted  
48 amount not later than thirty days after the end of such preceding fiscal  
49 year.

50 (b) All costs incurred in the administration of this part, except as  
51 provided in section 3-62h and subsection (a) of this section, and all  
52 claims allowed under this part shall be paid from the General Fund.

53 Sec. 504. Section 12-284b of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective*  
54 *from passage and applicable to taxable years commencing on or after January*  
55 *1, 2011*)"
