**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE REVENUE ITEMS IN THE BUDGET AND MAKING BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS, DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS, CERTAIN REVISIONS TO BILLS OF THE CURRENT SESSION AND MISCELLANEOUS CHANGES TO THE GENERAL STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 16-245f of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5 *passage*):

6 (c) The department, during the period commencing on January 1,  
7 2011, and ending June 30, 2011, shall assess or cause to be assessed a

8 charge per kilowatt hour of electricity sold to each end use customer of  
9 an electric distribution company and shall cause such assessments to  
10 be remitted to the General Fund. The department shall set such charge  
11 at a level which the department estimates will generate forty million  
12 dollars during the period it is assessed. Such charge shall not be  
13 assessed after [June 30, 2011] the effective date of this section. Any  
14 assessments collected but not yet remitted to the General Fund shall be  
15 refunded to each end use customer.

16 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
17 sections 4-30a and 4-30b of the general statutes, after the accounts for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, are closed, if the Comptroller  
19 determines there exists an unappropriated surplus in the General  
20 Fund, the amount of any such surplus shall first be used for returning  
21 to any end use customer who made payments pursuant to subsection  
22 (c) of section 16-245f of the general statutes, as amended by this act, an  
23 amount equal to such payments, or, should such unappropriated  
24 surplus be less than such amount, such surplus shall first be used for  
25 returning to any such end use customer a pro rata share of such  
26 payments."
