**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM  
ENDING JUNE 30, 2013."**

1 Strike section 13 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 13. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Not later than July 15, 2011, the  
4 Governor shall submit a plan to the joint standing committee of the  
5 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
6 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies and to the General  
7 Assembly through the clerks of the House of Representatives and  
8 Senate detailing any modifications to allotment requisitions or  
9 allotments in force the Governor deems necessary to make pursuant to  
10 section 4-85 of the general statutes or section 6 of this act and any  
11 reductions in expenditures for the executive branch the Governor  
12 approves pursuant to subsection (a) of section 8 of this act for the  
13 biennium ending June 30, 2013. Such committee shall hold a public  
14 hearing regarding such provisions and submit its findings to the

15 speaker of the House, majority leader of the House, minority leader of  
16 the House, president pro tempore of the Senate, majority leader of the  
17 Senate and minority leader of the Senate not later than August 15,  
18 2011. Not later than August 31, 2011, the General Assembly shall call  
19 itself into special session and may enact legislation that adjusts  
20 expenditures for the biennium ending June 30, 2013, by an amount  
21 equal to the amount of modifications or reductions proposed in any  
22 such provision or may reject such plan or any provision of such plan.  
23 No provision of such plan shall take effect without majority vote by  
24 both houses of the General Assembly.

25 (b) Not later than July 15, 2011, the Chief Court Administrator shall  
26 submit a plan to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly  
27 having cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the  
28 budgets of state agencies and to the General Assembly through the  
29 clerks of the House of Representatives and Senate detailing any  
30 reductions to judicial branch expenditures said administrator deems  
31 necessary to make pursuant to subsection (c) of section 8 of this act for  
32 the biennium ending June 30, 2013. Such committee shall hold a public  
33 hearing regarding such provisions and submit its findings to the  
34 speaker of the House, majority leader of the House, minority leader of  
35 the House, president pro tempore of the Senate, majority leader of the  
36 Senate and minority leader of the Senate not later than August 15,  
37 2011. Not later than August 31, 2011, the General Assembly shall call  
38 itself into special session and may enact legislation that adjusts  
39 expenditures for the biennium ending June 30, 2013, by an amount  
40 equal to the amount of reductions proposed in any such provision or  
41 may reject such plan or any provision of such plan. No provision of  
42 such plan shall take effect without majority vote by both houses of the  
43 General Assembly."
