**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE RATE APPROVAL PROCESS FOR CERTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2011*) (a) The Office of the  
4 Healthcare Advocate shall hire an actuary to be a full-time employee of  
5 said office to assist said office and the office of the Attorney General in  
6 any hearing required under section 6 of this act to which either office is  
7 a party. Notwithstanding chapter 68 of the general statutes, the salary  
8 and benefits of such employee shall be borne equally by said offices.

9 (b) Such actuary shall be a qualified actuary, as defined in section  
10 38a-78 of the general statutes, and shall have a minimum of ten years'  
11 experience in insurance underwriting, health insurance premium  
12 pricing or actuarial sciences.

13 (c) The Office of the Healthcare Advocate or the office of the  
14 Attorney General, or both, may engage the services of additional

15 actuaries not otherwise a part of said offices' staff as necessary to assist  
16 in any hearing required under section 6 of this act to which either  
17 office is a party. The expenses of such actuarial services shall be paid  
18 by the office that engages such services, or, if engaged jointly by both  
19 offices, shall be borne equally by said offices."
