"AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF BISPENOL-A IN THERMAL RECEIPT PAPER."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2013*) (a) For the purposes of
4 this section, "thermal receipt paper" or "cash register receipt paper"
5 means any paper that is used by a commercial entity to issue a
6 mechanically produced record of a commercial transaction.

7 (b) On and after October 1, 2013, no person shall manufacture, sell,
8 offer for sale or distribute in this state any thermal receipt paper or
9 cash register receipt paper that contains bisphenol-A.

10 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (b) of this section,
11 if the United States Environmental Protection Agency does not identify
12 a safe, commercially available alternative to the use of bisphenol-A in
13 thermal receipt paper or cash register receipt paper on or before June

14 30, 2013, no person shall manufacture, sell, offer for sale or distribute
15 in this state any thermal receipt paper or cash register receipt paper
16 that contains bisphenol-A on and after July 1, 2015.

17 (d) The provisions of this section may be enforced, within available
18 appropriations, by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection."
