"AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY OF ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

"Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 8-12a of the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2011*):

(c) Any zoning enforcement officer who issues a citation pursuant to an ordinance adopted under this section shall be liable for [treble] damages and attorneys' fees in any civil action if the court finds that

such citation was issued [frivolously or without probable cause] maliciously or wantonly. Each municipality shall, in accordance with section 7-101a, protect and save harmless any zoning enforcement officer of such municipality from financial loss and expense arising out of such civil action."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
