"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENHANCEMENT OF SERVICES AT THE LABOR DEPARTMENT AND THE USE OF CRIMINAL RECORDS FOR TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES OFFERED PERMANENT EMPLOYMENT BY AN EMPLOYER."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) On or before July 1, 2011, each
4 employer in the state, or the employer's insurer, shall provide an
5 electronic list to the chairman of the Workers' Compensation
6 Commission identifying any employee who made a claim to the
7 Workers' Compensation Commission for an injury that occurred
8 between July 1, 1993, and May 30, 2006, and began receiving
9 compensation for total incapacity pursuant to section 31-307 of the
10 general statutes and (1) had his or her compensation for total
11 incapacity reduced as a result of being eligible to receive old age
12 insurance benefits pursuant to the federal Social Security Act, and (2) is
13 still receiving such compensation as of July 1, 2011. Such list shall also
14 include confirmation from the employer or the employer's insurer that

15 each employee identified pursuant to this subsection has been
16 provided written notice, at such employee's last known address, from
17 the employer or the employer's insurer, that he or she may be entitled
18 to an increase in his or her compensation payment beginning January
19 1, 2012.

20 (b) On or after October 1, 2011, the chairman of the Workers'
21 Compensation Commission shall mail a written confirmation letter to
22 each employee identified in the lists provided under subsection (a) of
23 this section stating (1) that such employee should have received the
24 notice required under said subsection, and (2) that if the employee did
25 not receive such notice, he or she should call the Workers'
26 Compensation Commission.

27 (c) On or before January 1, 2012, the chairman of the Workers'
28 Compensation Commission shall order an adjustment of the
29 compensation paid on and after such date to any employee (1)
30 identified in a list provided under subsection (a) of this section, and (2)
31 meeting the requirements of said subsection (a) to the amount of
32 compensation owed the employee without the reduction for old age
33 insurance benefits.

34 (d) No employee identified pursuant to subsection (a) of this
35 section, who is provided additional compensation for total incapacity
36 pursuant to subsection (c) of this section, shall be eligible for additional
37 compensation for any compensation payments received prior to
38 January 1, 2012."
