**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM
ENDING JUNE 30, 2013."**

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- 1 Strike section 12 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:
- 3 "Sec. 12. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Any agreement reached through
4 negotiations between the state and the State Employees Bargaining
5 Unit Coalition (SEBAC) concerning wages, hours and other conditions
6 of employment to achieve the labor-management savings specified in
7 this act shall be filed with the General Assembly in accordance with
8 section 5-278 of the general statutes and Rule 31 of the Joint Rules of
9 this session, except as provided in this subsection. The General
10 Assembly shall approve such agreement as a whole by a majority vote
11 of each house or reject such agreement as a whole by a majority vote of

12 either house before the adjournment of the current regular session. If
13 the General Assembly fails to vote, such agreement shall not be
14 deemed approved.

15 (b) (1) On or before May 31, 2011, the Governor shall submit the
16 plan described in this subdivision in writing to the General Assembly.
17 If an agreement described in subsection (a) of this section has been
18 reached, such plan shall include (A) recommendations for legislation
19 to apply terms comparable to those contained in such agreement to
20 nonrepresented employees for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2012,
21 and June 30, 2013, and (B) if such agreement achieves less than two
22 billion dollars in savings over the biennium ending June 30, 2013,
23 recommendations for reductions in expenditures to achieve the
24 difference between that amount and two billion dollars. If no
25 agreement described in subsection (a) of this section has been reached,
26 such plan shall include recommendations for reductions in
27 expenditures not to exceed two billion dollars over the biennium
28 ending June 30, 2013.

29 (2) On or before June 8, 2011, the General Assembly shall enact
30 legislation to (A) apply terms comparable to those contained in an
31 agreement described in subsection (a) of this section and approved in
32 accordance with this section to nonrepresented employees for the fiscal
33 years ending June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013, and (B) achieve
34 reductions in expenditures not to exceed two billion dollars over the
35 biennium ending June 30, 2013, to the extent such savings have not
36 been achieved under any such agreement.

37 (c) The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall make
38 reductions in expenditures not to exceed two billion dollars over the
39 biennium ending June 30, 2013, (1) as provided in an agreement
40 described in subsection (a) of this section and approved in accordance
41 with this section for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2012, and June 30,
42 2013, and (2) contained in legislation enacted by the General Assembly
43 under subdivision (2) of subsection (b) of this section."
