Title: AN ACT CONCERNING AUTOMOTIVE GLASS WORK AND REPAIRS.

Statement of Purpose: To (a) prohibit insurance companies from (1) referring or routing its insureds to third-party adjusters or third-party claims administrators for certain automobile repairs or replacements without directly contacting the insurance company first, and (2) guaranteeing or warranting such repairs or replacements or imposing monetary advantages or penalties that could affect an insured's choice of a repair shop or facility, and (b) to require disclosure of the insured's right to choose where automobile repair or replacement work will be performed.
