**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING SUFFICIENT NUMBERS OF BALLOTS AT POLLING PLACES.

**Statement of Purpose:** To require the proper amount of ballots to be printed during elections held in gubernatorial and presidential year elections and special elections and primaries, as determined by the Secretary of the State along with the registrars of voters and town clerks, and to require the state to purchase in bulk those ballots with some funding from the Citizens' Election Fund, to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to cast their vote.
