Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFICE OF STATE ETHICS.

Statement of Purpose: To allow notaries public and justices of the peace to serve on the Citizen's Ethics Advisory Board, to stagger appointments to said board, to allow reappointments to the board, to permit members of said board to serve to adjudicate at a board hearing for a pending matter, to require prospective members of said board to certify that they are aware of the special restrictions of the Code of Ethics for Public Officials that would apply to them, to clarify that a violation of section 1-101nn of the general statutes is grounds for being deemed a nonresponsible bidder, to limit the violation contained in section 1-84 of the general statutes to knowing violations, and to prohibit the staff and members of the Citizen's Ethics Advisory Board and the Office of State Ethics from participating in political campaigns.
