Title: AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ELECTRONIC BUSINESS PORTAL AT THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE.

Statement of Purpose: To require the Secretary of the State, Labor Commissioner, and Commissioners of Revenue Services, Administrative Services, Consumer Protection, Public Works and Transportation, or their designees, to develop a unified state identification number to be used for all transactions with the state, ease electronic filing by business entities in the state, ease information sharing between state agencies and create an electronic business portal to facilitate new businesses in the state.
