Title: AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE.

Statement of Purpose: To provide that (1) whenever a child convicted as a delinquent and committed to DCF custody is subsequently arrested for a juvenile offense, the child gets credit for time spent in detention prior to the disposition of the offense; (2) that any admission, confession or statement made by a child to a police officer or Juvenile Court official is inadmissible in any criminal prosecution of the child; and (3) that the Commissioner of Children and Families adopt revised regulations regarding standard leave and release policies that would provide more flexibility in determining the need for a sixty-day evaluation of fitness and security prior to leave or release.
