Title: AN ACT ESTABLISHING A UNIFORM STATE LICENSING PROCESS FOR PRIVATE COMMUNITY-BASED PROVIDERS.

Statement of Purpose: To study the feasibility of establishing a uniform state licensing process which permits a community-based provider to obtain a single license that allows the provider to offer services for the benefit of multiple state agencies without requiring such provider to obtain separate licensure from each state agency for which services are offered.
