Title: AN ACT CONCERNING LICENSING AGREEMENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, THE PREQUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS AND BID PROTESTS.

Statement of Purpose: To give the Department of Public Works the right to enter into licensing agreements concerning state property, to exempt such agreements from the requirement that the department notify the municipality where the property is located, to redefine prequalification, to allow an exception to the requirement that a contractor or subcontractor be prequalified to perform work under a contract or subcontractor, to require the rejection of a bid by a bidder who has received three or more unsatisfactory evaluations in seven years, to clarify that only general bidders have the right to institute a bid protest and to redefine procurement to exclude contracts for interest in real property from the definition.
