Title: AN ACT CONCERNING SCRAP METAL PROCESSORS, PROFESSIONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL RETIREMENT STATUS LICENSES, AND GENERIC DRUG PRODUCT SUBSTITUTIONS.

Statement of Purpose: To require persons delivering scrap metal to scrap metal processors to certify the origin of such metal, to improve enforcement of certain professional and occupational licensing, certification and registration laws, to authorize the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to issue retirement status licenses for certain occupations and trades, to prohibit certain abusive debt collection practices, to require the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to revise the residential property condition disclosure report form and to require pharmacists to provide more effective notice to patients who receive generic drug substitutes.
