**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF INDIVIDUALS FROM THE STATE CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT REGISTRY.

**Statement of Purpose:** To: (1) Clarify the prerequisites for the Department of Children and Families to conduct an interview of a child without the consent of the parents, guardians or other person responsible for the care of the child; and (2) establish a procedure for individuals to remove their names from the state child abuse and neglect registry after five years have elapsed and upon the showing of good cause.
