**Title:** AN ACT CONCERNING EVIDENCE AND DETENTION IN JUVENILE MATTERS.

**Statement of Purpose:** To provide that: (1) A child convicted as a delinquent and committed to the custody of the Commissioner of Children and Families shall receive credit for time spent in detention prior to the disposition of the offense; (2) any admission, confession or statement made by a child to a police officer or Juvenile Court official is inadmissible in any criminal prosecution of the child; and (3) the Commissioner of Children and Families may waive the requirement for a sixty-day evaluation of fitness and security and award passes for leave to children convicted as delinquent who have had such evaluation and subsequently transfer to a different facility.
