

Dear Members of the Judicial Committee,

As a taxpayer in the town of Montville and a parent of two teenaged daughters, I am strongly opposed to Montville being chosen as the site of the residential sex offender facility. I have attended several meetings regarding this facility and question the process that was taken to decide Montville as the appropriate site. I feel with daycares, the youth service bureau, a school, many businesses and our senior center in close proximity to the chosen site that the State would consider finding a more appropriate location. Montville is not the right site for this facility.

With the Judicial Committee passing House Bill 6632, the criteria of selecting sites for facilities such as this will be more definitively outlined and a Town like Montville won't suffer bearing such a facility.

I also encourage the Assembly and State to reevaluate the criteria which is currently outlined in choosing such sites as well as the areas which Montville truly qualified for and you will notice a mistake was made in choosing Montville as the appropriate site.

Please consider passing House Bill 6632.
