"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENHANCEMENT OF SERVICES AT THE LABOR DEPARTMENT AND THE USE OF CRIMINAL RECORDS FOR TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES OFFERED PERMANENT EMPLOYMENT BY AN EMPLOYER."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The joint enforcement commission
4 on employee misclassification established pursuant to section 31-57h of
5 the general statutes shall study employee misclassification in the
6 homemaker-companion agency industry. Such study shall include, but
7 not be limited to, evaluating whether (1) homemaker-companion
8 agencies that operate as registries or provide referral services should
9 classify persons providing homemaker services through such agencies
10 as employees of the agency, (2) such agencies should be subject to
11 unemployment tax for such persons, and (3) such agencies should be
12 required to have workers' compensation coverage for such persons.
13 Not later than January 1, 2012, the commission shall submit, in
14 accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, findings and

15 recommendations to the joint standing committees of the General
16 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to aging and public
17 health."
