- 2 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
- 3 internal references accordingly:
- 4 "Sec. 501. Section 7-282c of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 5 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2011*):
- 6 Any municipal police department which receives a report of a
- 7 missing child under [fifteen] eighteen years of age or a missing person
- 8 who is eligible for assistance under subsection (a) of section 29-1f shall
- 9 immediately accept such report for filing and inform all on-duty police
- 10 officers of the existence of the missing child or missing person report
- 11 and communicate the report to other appropriate law enforcement
- 12 agencies."
