**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE EDUCATION STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
4 section 10-292 of the general statutes or any regulation adopted by the  
5 State Board of Education requiring that a bid not be let out until plans  
6 and specifications have been approved by the Department of  
7 Education's Bureau of School Facilities, the town of West Haven may  
8 let out for bid on and commence a project for alteration and energy  
9 conservation (Project Number 156-0127) at the West Haven High  
10 School and shall be eligible to subsequently be considered for a grant  
11 commitment from the state, provided plans and specifications have  
12 been approved by the Department of Education's Bureau of School

13 Facilities.

14 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
15 section 10-287 of the general statutes or any regulation adopted by the  
16 State Board of Education pursuant to said section 10-287 requiring a  
17 competitive bidding process for orders and contracts for school  
18 building construction receiving state assistance under chapter 173 of  
19 the general statutes, the town of West Haven shall not be required to  
20 conduct such process for orders and contracts for the portion of the  
21 project for alteration and energy conservation (Project Number 156-  
22 0127) at the West Haven High School."
