**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM
ENDING JUNE 30, 2013."**

1 Strike section 120 in its entirety and renumber the remaining
2 sections and internal references accordingly.

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the
6 provisions of section 9-750 of the general statutes, on and after the
7 effective date of this section, (1) no funds received by the State
8 Treasurer under part III of chapter 32 of the general statutes and
9 deposited in the General Fund shall be credited to the Citizens'
10 Election Fund established in section 9-701 of the general statutes, and
11 (2) no revenues from the tax imposed under chapter 208 of the general

12 statutes shall be deposited in the Citizens' Election Fund.

13 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 157 of the general
14 statutes, no grants shall be paid from the Citizens' Election Fund.

15 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
16 section 9-701 of the general statutes, on or after July 1, 2011, any funds
17 remaining on June 30, 2011, in the Citizens' Election Fund established
18 in section 9-701 of the general statutes shall be transferred from said
19 fund and credited to the resources of the General Fund for the fiscal
20 year ending June 30, 2012.

21 Sec. 503. Section 3-69a of the general statutes is repealed and the
22 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

23 (a) (1) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the funds received
24 under this part, excluding the proceeds from the sale of property
25 deposited in the Special Abandoned Property Fund in accordance with
26 section 3-62h, shall be deposited in the General Fund.

27 (2) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, [and each fiscal year
28 thereafter] to the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, inclusive, a portion
29 of the funds received under this part shall, upon deposit in the General
30 Fund, be credited to the Citizens' Election Fund established in section
31 9-701 as follows: (A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, seventeen
32 million dollars, (B) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, sixteen
33 million dollars, (C) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, seventeen
34 million three hundred thousand dollars, and (D) for the fiscal year
35 ending June 30, 2009, [and each fiscal year thereafter] through the fiscal
36 year ending June 30, 2011, inclusive, the amount deposited for the
37 preceding fiscal year, adjusted in accordance with any change in the
38 consumer price index for all urban consumers for such preceding fiscal
39 year, as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau
40 of Labor Statistics. The State Treasurer shall determine such adjusted
41 amount not later than thirty days after the end of such preceding fiscal
42 year.

43 (b) All costs incurred in the administration of this part, except as
44 provided in section 3-62h and subsection (a) of this section, and all
45 claims allowed under this part shall be paid from the General Fund."
