**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM
ENDING JUNE 30, 2013."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than December 31,
4 2011, the Department of Consumer Protection shall, within available
5 appropriations, conduct a study of the three tier system of alcoholic
6 beverage distribution in the state and shall determine whether existing
7 law sufficiently protects the general public and whether such system
8 results in reasonable alcoholic beverage consumer pricing compared to
9 other states. Not later than December 31, 2011, said department shall
10 submit a report with the results of such study, in accordance with the
11 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing

- 12 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
13 relating to alcoholic beverages."
