**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVISION OF MUNICIPAL CHARTERS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 1 of number 460 of the special acts of 1935 is  
4 amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

5 (a) At the annual meeting of the Thompsonville Fire and Sewer  
6 District in June, 1935, three electors of said district shall be chosen by  
7 ballot as a board of fire commissioners. One of said commissioners  
8 shall be chosen to serve until February, 1936, one until February, 1937,  
9 and one until February, 1938, and, at each subsequent annual meeting  
10 of said district to be held as hereinafter provided, one member of said  
11 board shall be elected who shall serve for a term of three years and  
12 until his successor shall be elected. At said annual meeting and  
13 annually thereafter, there shall be elected two auditors for said district  
14 who shall audit the records of the tax collector and treasurer of said  
15 district and report to the succeeding annual district meeting.

16       (b) Any elector of said district who intends to announce his or her  
17 candidacy as a member of the board of fire commissioners must file a  
18 notice of such intent with the town clerk of Enfield not less than thirty  
19 days before the date of the annual meeting. For any election, voting  
20 shall remain open from six o'clock a.m. to eight o'clock p.m.

21       Sec. 502. Section 3 of number 460 of the special acts of 1935 is  
22 amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

23       Said board of fire commissioners shall have the authority formerly  
24 granted by special legislative acts to the Thompsonville Fire District  
25 and to "School District No. 2 of Enfield", and shall re-organize the fire  
26 department and make all necessary rules and regulations for the  
27 control of the same and the discipline of the members thereof. All  
28 apparatus, equipment, buildings and machinery owned and used by  
29 the Thompsonville Fire District for protection of property from fire  
30 shall be under the control and management of said board. Said board  
31 shall appoint a chief of the department [, a deputy chief and a  
32 superintendent of fire alarms,] and an assistant chief who shall be  
33 subject to such orders, rules and regulations as the board may, from  
34 time to time, enact, and may be discharged or removed by said board  
35 whenever it shall deem such action for the best interests of the district."
