"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) Upon the conviction in
4 federal court of any qualifying patient, primary caregiver or physician
5 for a violation of any provision of federal law concerning the
6 possession of marijuana or paraphernalia related to marijuana when
7 such possession is permissible under any provision of sections 1 to 9,
8 inclusive, of this act, the provisions of sections 1 to 9, inclusive, of this
9 act shall cease to be effective and the Commissioner of Consumer
10 Protection shall cease activity under said sections until such time as a
11 court of competent jurisdiction overturns such conviction, except that
12 if such conviction is not overturned by a court of competent
13 jurisdiction by the date that is two years after the date of such
14 conviction, sections 1 to 9, inclusive, of this act shall be deemed
15 repealed."
