"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2011*) The Department of Public Safety
4 shall study the impact of the legalization of palliative marijuana use in
5 the state of Maine and shall analyze (1) the impact on the state of
6 Maine's local and state police departments of the enforcement of
7 fraudulent claims of palliative use associated with such legalization,
8 and (2) the overall increase of arrests for the illegal use of marijuana in
9 the state of Maine. Not later than February 1, 2012, the department
10 shall report its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
11 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
12 relating to public safety, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
13 general statutes."
