 - 8 and a representative of the Connecticut Police Chiefs Association,
 - 9 shall, not later than January 1, 2012, establish standards for the
 - 10 equipment to be used in the electronic recording of custodial
 - 11 interrogations pursuant to section 1 of this act, including the
 - 12 transcription of such recording, and for the training and certification of

13 law enforcement personnel in the operation of such equipment."
