"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET CONCERNING THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, CHILD PROTECTION, CRIMINAL JUSTICE, WEIGH STATIONS AND CERTAIN STATE AGENCY CONSOLIDATIONS."

1 After line 1039, add the following:

2 "(f) (1) The commissioner shall not implement the policies and
3 procedures developed for the award of risk reduction credits pursuant
4 to this section until such policies and procedures have been submitted
5 to the General Assembly and approved as provided in this subsection.

6 (2) If the General Assembly is in regular session, such proposed
7 policies and procedures shall be submitted to the clerks of the House
8 of Representatives and the Senate and be referred to the joint standing
9 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
10 relating to criminal justice. If the General Assembly is not in regular
11 session, such proposed policies and procedures shall be submitted to
12 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
13 cognizance of matters relating to criminal justice.

14 (3) Said committee may convene a meeting within thirty days of the
15 date of such submission to recommend to the General Assembly
16 approval or disapproval of such proposed policies and procedures. If
17 said committee fails to make a recommendation within such time
18 period, the proposed policies and procedures shall be deemed
19 approved.

20 (4) If the committee makes a recommendation and the General
21 Assembly is in session, the House of Representatives and the Senate
22 may vote to approve or disapprove such proposed policies and
23 procedures within thirty days of the date of such recommendation. If
24 such proposed policies and procedures are not disapproved by both
25 the House of Representatives and the Senate within such time period,
26 the proposed policies and procedures shall be deemed approved.

27 (5) If the committee makes a recommendation and the General
28 Assembly is not in session, the proposed policies and procedures shall
29 be deemed approved unless the General Assembly convenes in regular
30 or special session and both the House of Representatives and the
31 Senate vote to disapprove such proposed policies and procedures
32 within thirty days of the date of such recommendation.

33 (6) If both the House of Representatives and the Senate vote to
34 disapprove such proposed policies and procedures, such proposed
35 policies and procedures shall be returned to the commissioner for
36 revision."
