"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET CONCERNING THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, CHILD PROTECTION, CRIMINAL JUSTICE, WEIGH STATIONS AND CERTAIN STATE AGENCY CONSOLIDATIONS."

1 Strike lines 1800 to 1806, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) The Commissioner of [Public Safety] Emergency Services and
4 Public Protection, in consultation with the Commissioner of Motor
5 Vehicles, shall assign [personnel from the traffic unit to work between
6 nine and twelve shifts] one trooper to each weighing area working
7 shift in each seven-day period from Sunday through Saturday to
8 [patrol and] enforce laws relative to the safe movement of all vehicles
9 on the highways of the state, except that, notwithstanding any
10 provision of the general statutes or of any public or special act, the
11 Commissioner of Emergency Services and Public Protection shall
12 assign one trooper to each weighing area in Greenwich, Danbury and
13 Union, for at least fifty per cent of the time in each seven-day period

- 14 from Sunday through Saturday during which such weighing area is
15 open, to enforce such laws on the highways of the state."
