**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DENIAL OF UNEMPLOYMENT
COMPENSATION BENEFITS TO CERTAIN DRIVERS WHO ARE
UNEMPLOYED AS A RESULT OF BEING DENIED A SPECIAL
OPERATOR'S PERMIT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (14) of subsection (a) of section 31-236 of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2011*):

6 (14) If the administrator finds that the individual has been
7 discharged or suspended because the individual has been disqualified
8 under state or federal law from performing the work for which such
9 individual was hired (A) as a result of a drug or alcohol testing
10 program mandated by and conducted in accordance with such law, or
11 (B) as a result of the suspension or revocation of an individual's public
12 passenger permit or commercial driver's license, unless the individual

13 provides documentation from the Department of Motor Vehicles or the
14 United States Department of Transportation indicating the reason for
15 the suspension or denial of the individual's license is based on any
16 provision of 49 CFR 391.41 to 49 CFR 391.49, inclusive, until such
17 individual has earned at least ten times such individual's benefit rate;"
