"AN ACT MANDATING EMPLOYERS PROVIDE PAID SICK LEAVE TO EMPLOYEES."

1 Strike subdivision (4) of section 1 in its entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(4) "Employer" means any person, firm, business, educational
4 institution, nonprofit agency, corporation, limited liability company or
5 other entity that employs fifty or more individuals in the state in any
6 one quarter in the previous year, which shall be determined on
7 January first, annually. Such determination shall be made based upon
8 the wage information submitted to the Labor Commissioner by the
9 employer pursuant to subsection (j) of section 31-225a of the general
10 statutes. "Employer" does not include (A) any political subdivision of
11 the state, (B) any business establishment classified in sector 31, 32 or 33
12 in the North American Industrial Classification System, or (C) any

13 nationally chartered organization exempt from taxation under Section
14 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent
15 corresponding internal revenue code of the United States, as from time
16 to time amended, that provides all of the following services:
17 Recreation, child care and education;"
