**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE CONNECTICUT HEALTHCARE PARTNERSHIP."**

1 Strike section 11 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 11. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Office of Health  
4 Reform and Innovation established under subsection (b) of section 13  
5 of this act shall convene a working group to develop a plan to  
6 implement a state-wide multipayer data initiative to enhance the  
7 state's use of health care data from multiple sources to increase  
8 efficiency, enhance outcomes and improve the understanding of health  
9 care expenditures in the public and private sectors. Such group shall  
10 include, but not be limited to, the Secretary of the Office of Policy and  
11 Management, the Comptroller, the Commissioners of Public Health  
12 and Social Services, the Insurance Commissioner, representatives of

13 health insurance companies, health insurance purchasers, hospitals,  
14 consumer advocates and health care providers.

15 (b) The Office of Health Reform and Innovation shall submit, in  
16 accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, a report on such  
17 plan to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having  
18 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations, insurance and public  
19 health."
