"AN ACT REQUIRING DNA TESTING OF PERSONS ARRESTED FOR THE COMMISSION OF A SERIOUS FELONY."

1 In line 4, after "felony" insert "and, prior to such arrest, has been
2 convicted of a felony but has not submitted to the taking of a blood or
3 other biological sample for DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) analysis
4 pursuant to this section"

5 In line 82, after "Safety" insert ", except that the division shall
6 analyze samples taken pursuant to subsection (a) of this section only as
7 available resources allow"

8 In line 86, after "102j" insert ", as amended by this act"

9 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and

10 internal references accordingly:

11 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 54-102j of the general statutes is
12 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
13 *October 1, 2011*):

14 (a) It shall be the duty of the Division of Scientific Services within
15 the Department of Public Safety to receive blood or other biological
16 samples and to analyze, classify and file the results of DNA
17 identification characteristics profiles of blood or other biological
18 samples submitted pursuant to section 54-102g, as amended by this
19 act, and to make such information available as provided in this section,
20 except that the division shall analyze samples taken pursuant to
21 subsection (a) of section 54-102g, as amended by this act, only as
22 available resources allow. The results of an analysis and comparison of
23 the identification characteristics from two or more blood or other
24 biological samples shall be made available directly to federal, state and
25 local law enforcement officers upon request made in furtherance of an
26 official investigation of any criminal offense. A request may be made
27 by personal contact, mail or electronic means. The name of the person
28 making the request and the purpose for which the information is
29 requested shall be maintained on file with the division."
