**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."**

1 In lines 1, 147, 155, 164, 167, 191, 194, 200 and 225, strike "1 to 9" and  
2 substitute "1 to 10" in lieu thereof

3 In line 114, after "physician" and before the period, insert "unless  
4 revoked by the department pursuant to section 10 of this act"

5 After line 211, insert the following and renumber sections and  
6 internal references accordingly:

7 "Sec. 10. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) The Commissioner of  
8 Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with  
9 chapter 54 of the general statutes, to establish a standard of care for the  
10 palliative use of marijuana under sections 1 to 9, inclusive, of this act.  
11 At a minimum, such standard of care shall provide that during any  
12 period when a qualifying patient holds an effective registration  
13 certificate pursuant to subsection (a) of section 3 of this act, the  
14 qualifying patient shall be subject to periodic chemical analysis of such  
15 qualifying patient's blood, breath or urine for the purpose of

16 determining whether the qualifying patient has ingested, inhaled or  
17 otherwise introduced into such qualifying patient's body a controlled  
18 substance that has not been prescribed by a physician. The Department  
19 of Consumer Protection shall revoke a registration certificate for any  
20 qualifying patient who fails to comply with such testing requirement,  
21 or for whom such analysis indicates the presence of a controlled  
22 substance that has not been prescribed by a physician."
