**"AN ACT MANDATING EMPLOYERS PROVIDE PAID SICK LEAVE TO EMPLOYEES."**

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1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established the  
4 "Paid Sick Leave Reimbursement Fund" which shall be a separate,  
5 nonlapsing account within the General Fund. Fifty per cent of the  
6 revenue collected annually pursuant to section 12-284b of the general  
7 statutes shall be deposited in said fund.

8 (b) Any employer who provides paid sick leave in accordance with  
9 sections 1 to 6, inclusive, of this act may apply to the Labor  
10 Commissioner for reimbursement in an amount equal to one hundred  
11 per cent of the amount such employer is required to pay a service  
12 worker who is performing the work normally performed by a service  
13 worker who is using sick leave.

14 (c) The Labor Commissioner shall promulgate regulations for the  
15 reimbursement of employers for the provision of paid sick leave from  
16 the Paid Sick Leave Reimbursement Fund pursuant to this section.

17 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Comptroller shall  
18 reserve an amount equal to fifty per cent of the revenue collected  
19 annually pursuant to section 12-248b of the general statutes, which  
20 shall be used to pay any federal obligation related to the provision of  
21 benefits pursuant to chapter 567 of the general statutes."
