**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PALLIATIVE USE OF MARIJUANA."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) The Department of  
4 Consumer Protection shall establish an investigational review board  
5 for the purpose of requiring physicians who issue written certifications  
6 to provide the board with valid medical research that indicates that  
7 marijuana is an effective treatment for the debilitating medical  
8 condition for which the written certification is issued. The  
9 Commissioner of Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in  
10 accordance with chapter 54 of the general statutes, to implement the  
11 provisions of this section. On and after the date such regulations are  
12 effective, each physician who issues a written certification shall submit  
13 information to the board in the manner prescribed in such  
14 regulations."
