**"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF THE BUDGET
CONCERNING GENERAL GOVERNMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 2-35 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2011*):

6 (b) The state budget act passed by the legislature for funding the
7 expenses of operations of the state government in the ensuing
8 biennium shall contain (1) a statement of estimated current
9 expenditures for the fiscal year in effect immediately preceding such
10 ensuing biennium, and (2) a statement of estimated revenue, based
11 upon the most recent consensus revenue estimate or the revised
12 consensus revenue estimate issued pursuant to section 2-36c, itemized
13 by major source, for each appropriated fund. The statement of
14 estimated revenue applicable to each such fund shall include, for any
15 fiscal year, an estimate of total revenue with respect to such fund,

16 which amount shall be reduced by [(1)] (A) an estimate of total refunds
17 of taxes to be paid from such revenue in accordance with the
18 authorization in section 12-39f, and [(2)] (B) an estimate of total
19 refunds of payments to be paid from such revenue in accordance with
20 the provisions of section 4-37. Such statement of estimated revenue,
21 including the estimated refunds of taxes to be offset against such
22 revenue, shall be supplied by the joint standing committee of the
23 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to state
24 finance, revenue and bonding. The total estimated revenue for each
25 fund, as adjusted in accordance with this section, shall not be less than
26 the total net appropriations made from each fund. On or before July
27 first of each fiscal year said committee shall, if any revisions in such
28 estimates are required by virtue of legislative amendments to the
29 revenue measures proposed by said committee, changes in conditions
30 or receipt of new information since the original estimate was supplied,
31 meet and revise such estimates and, through its cochairpersons, report
32 to the Comptroller any such revisions."
