**"AN ACT CONCERNING DISCRIMINATION."**

1 After section 37, add the following:

2 "Sec. 38. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) Nothing in subsection (a)

17 on the basis of gender identity or expression shall be deemed or  
18 construed to: (1) Mean the state of Connecticut condones  
19 transvestitism, transsexuality, gender spectrum theory or any  
20 equivalent lifestyle associated with gender identity or expression, (2)  
21 authorize the promotion of transvestitism, transsexuality, gender  
22 spectrum theory or any equivalent lifestyle associated with gender  
23 identity or expression in educational institutions or authorize the  
24 teaching in educational institutions of transvestitism, transsexuality,  
25 gender spectrum theory or any equivalent lifestyle associated with  
26 gender identity disorder as an acceptable lifestyle, (3) authorize or  
27 permit the use of numerical goals or quotas, or other types of  
28 affirmative action programs, with respect to transvestitism,  
29 transsexuality, gender spectrum theory or any equivalent lifestyle  
30 associated with gender identity or expression in the administration or  
31 enforcement of the provisions of subsection (a) of section 4a-60,  
32 subsection (c) of section 8-169s, section 8-265c, subsection (c) of section  
33 8-294, section 8-315, subsection (a) of section 10-15c, section 10-153,  
34 subsection (b) of section 10a-6, subsection (a) of section 11-24b, sections  
35 16-245r and 16-247r, subsection (b) of section 28-15, section 31-22p,  
36 subsection (e) of section 31-57e, sections 32-204, 32-277, 38a-358 and 42-  
37 125a, subsection (c) of section 42-125b, subsection (a) of section 46a-58,
