1 After line 80, insert the following:

2 "(g) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (b) to (e),
3 inclusive, of this section, any person who is convicted, on or after the
4 effective date of this section, of a serious felony offense, as such term is
5 defined in section 54-82t, shall, prior to the time scheduled for such
6 person to be sentenced, submit to the taking of a blood or other
7 biological sample for DNA analysis to determine identification
8 characteristics specific to the person."

9 In line 81, delete "(g)" and insert in lieu thereof "(h)"

10 In line 87, delete "(h)" and insert in lieu thereof "(i)"

11 After line 134, insert the following:

12 "(7) The collection of a blood or other biological sample from
13 persons required to submit to the taking of such sample pursuant to

14 subsection (g) of section 54-102g, as amended by this act, shall be the
15 responsibility of the Judicial Department and shall be taken at a time
16 and place specified by the Court Support Services Division prior to the
17 time scheduled for the sentencing of such persons."
