**"AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTRATION FOR CRIMES
COMMITTED WITH A FIREARM."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) For the purposes of
4 sections 1 to 5, inclusive, of this act:

5 (1) "Conviction" means a judgment entered in this state by a court
6 upon a plea of guilty, a plea of nolo contendere or a finding of guilty
7 by a jury or the court notwithstanding any pending appeal or habeas
8 corpus proceeding arising from such judgment;

9 (2) "Gun offense" means a violation of: Subsection (c) of section 2-1e,
10 subsection (a), (b) or (i) of section 29-33, section 29-34, subsection (a) of
11 section 29-35, section 29-36, 29-36k, 29-37e or 29-37j, subsection (b), (c)
12 or (g) of section 53-202, section 53-202b, 53-202c, 53-202j, 53-202k or 53-

13 202aa, subsection (b) of section 53a-8, section 53a-55a, 53a-56a, 53a-60a,
14 53a-60c, 53a-72b, 53a-92a, 53a-94a, 53a-102a, 53a-103a, 53a-211, 53a-212,
15 53a-217a, 53a-217b or 53a-217c of the general statutes; and

16 (3) "Gun offender" means a person who has been convicted of any
17 gun offense.

18 Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) (a) The chief of police of any
19 city having a population in excess of forty-five thousand may require
20 any gun offender who resides in that city and who, on or after the
21 effective date of this section, is on pretrial release, probation, parole or
22 other community release with respect to the alleged commission of, or
23 conviction of, any offense and subject to supervision by the Court
24 Support Services Division of the Judicial Branch, the Department of
25 Correction or the Board of Pardons and Paroles, to register with the
26 police department of that city in accordance with section 3 of this act.

27 (b) Whenever a chief of police requires any gun offender to register
28 as provided in subsection (a) of this section, the Court Support Services
29 Division of the Judicial Branch, the Department of Correction and the
30 Board of Pardons and Paroles shall, upon request of such chief of
31 police, cooperate and provide such records, information and assistance
32 as may be necessary in order for the police department to implement,
33 and ensure compliance with, the registration requirements of section 3
34 of this act including, but not limited to, providing to such chief of
35 police the names and current residence addresses of gun offenders
36 who reside in that city and are subject to supervision by said division,
37 department or board, as the case may be.

38 Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) (a) Any gun offender
39 residing in a city in which the chief of police has in accordance with
40 section 2 of this act elected to require certain gun offenders to register,
41 shall, upon notification by such police department, personally appear
42 at the municipal police department of that city not later than forty-
43 eight hours after receipt of such notification for purposes of registering
44 as a gun offender in that city.

45 (b) The registration shall include:

46 (1) The gun offender's name, including any other name by which
47 the gun offender has been legally known, and any aliases used by the
48 gun offender;

49 (2) Identifying information, including a physical description of the
50 gun offender;

51 (3) The current residence address of the gun offender;

52 (4) The date of conviction of the gun offense;

53 (5) A description of the gun offense; and

54 (6) If the gun offender was sentenced to a term of incarceration for
55 such gun offense, a portion of which was not suspended, the date the
56 gun offender was released from confinement.

57 (c) The gun offender shall sign and date the registration.

58 (d) At the time that the gun offender appears for purposes of
59 registering, such municipal police department may photograph the
60 gun offender for inclusion of such photograph in the registration.

61 (e) The municipal police department may require the gun offender
62 to provide documentation to verify the contents of his or her
63 registration.

64 (f) Any gun offender required to register under this section shall,
65 not later than twenty days after each anniversary date of such initial
66 registration, and until the date supervision by the Court Support
67 Services Division of the Judicial Branch, the Department of Correction
68 or the Board of Pardons and Paroles terminates, personally appear at
69 the police department, to verify and update, as appropriate, the
70 contents of his or her registration.

71 (g) Any gun offender required to register pursuant to this section
72 who changes such person's residence address within the city shall, not

73 later than forty-eight hours after such change, personally appear at the
74 police department to update such person's registration information.

75 Sec. 4. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) Whenever a chief of police
76 requires any gun offender to register as provided in section 3 of this
77 act, the Court Support Services Division of the Judicial Branch, the
78 Department of Correction and the Board of Pardons and Paroles, as the
79 case may be, shall make compliance with such registration
80 requirements a condition of such offender's release, probation or
81 parole.

82 Sec. 5. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) A municipal police
83 department shall maintain registration information required under
84 section 3 of this act during the period a gun offender is under the
85 supervision of the Court Support Services Division of the Judicial
86 Branch, the Department of Correction or the Board of Pardons and
87 Paroles."
