**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SITING OF RESIDENTIAL SEXUAL OFFENDER TREATMENT FACILITIES."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) (a) For the purposes of  
4 this section:

5 (1) "Registrant" means a person required to register under chapter  
6 969 of the general statutes;

7 (2) "Maximum registrant population" for a town means the number  
8 calculated by dividing the total number of registrants in the state as  
9 determined by the most recent registration information maintained by  
10 the Department of Public Safety pursuant to chapter 969 of the general  
11 statutes, by the total population of the state as determined by the most  
12 recent decennial census, and then multiplying the quotient by the  
13 population of that town as determined by the most recent decennial  
14 census.

15 (b) On January 1, 2012, and annually thereafter, the Office of Policy  
 16 and Management shall determine the maximum registrant population  
 17 for each town in the state.

18 (c) Whenever the number of registrants residing in a town as  
 19 determined by the most recent registration information maintained by  
 20 the Department of Public Safety pursuant to chapter 969 of the general  
 21 statutes exceeds the maximum registrant population for that town as  
 22 most recently determined pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, the  
 23 Department of Correction, the Board of Pardons and Paroles and the  
 24 Judicial Branch shall not release a registrant into the community to an  
 25 address in that town, unless such registrant was a bona fide resident of  
 26 that town prior to conviction of the offense that caused such  
 27 registration. For purposes of this subsection, "bona fide resident" does  
 28 not include a resident of a halfway house, group home or homeless  
 29 shelter.

30 (d) If the Department of Correction, the Board of Pardons and  
 31 Paroles and the Judicial Branch are prohibited from releasing a  
 32 registrant to a town pursuant to subsection (c) of this section, the  
 33 department, board or branch, as the case may be, shall provide suitable  
 34 accommodations for such registrant in a town whose number of  
 35 registrants residing therein does not exceed the maximum registrant  
 36 population for that town as most recently determined pursuant to  
 37 subsection (b) of this section."
