***"AN ACT MANDATING EMPLOYERS PROVIDE PAID SICK LEAVE TO EMPLOYEES."***

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1 Strike subdivision (4) of section 1 in its entirety and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(4) "Employer" means any person, firm, business, educational  
4 institution, nonprofit agency, corporation, limited liability company or  
5 other entity that employs fifty or more individuals in the state in any  
6 one quarter in the previous year, which shall be determined on  
7 January first, annually. Such determination shall be made based upon  
8 the wage information submitted to the Labor Commissioner by the  
9 employer pursuant to subsection (j) of section 31-225a of the general  
10 statutes. "Employer" does not include: (A) Any business establishment  
11 classified in sector 31, 32 or 33 in the North American Industrial  
12 Classification System, (B) any federally-qualified health center, or (C)

13 any nationally chartered organization exempt from taxation under  
14 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any  
15 subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the United States,  
16 as from time to time amended, that provides all of the following  
17 services: Recreation, child care and education;"
