**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL POSSESSION AND SEIZURE OF FIREARM AMMUNITION."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 29-31 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2011*):

5 No sale of any pistol or revolver shall be made except in the room,  
6 store or place described in the permit for the sale of pistols and  
7 revolvers, and such permit or a copy [thereof] of such permit certified  
8 by the authority issuing the same shall be exposed to view within the  
9 room, store or place where pistols or revolvers are sold or offered or  
10 exposed for sale, and no sale or delivery of any pistol or revolver shall  
11 be made unless the purchaser or person to whom the same is to be  
12 delivered is personally known to the vendor of such pistol or revolver  
13 or the person making delivery [thereof] of such pistol or revolver or  
14 unless the person making such purchase or to whom delivery thereof

15 is to be made provides evidence of his or her identity. The vendor of  
16 any pistol or revolver shall keep a record of each pistol or revolver sold  
17 in a book kept for that purpose, which record shall be in such form as  
18 is prescribed by [the Commissioner of Public Safety and shall include  
19 the date of the sale, the caliber, make, model and manufacturer's  
20 number of such pistol or revolver and the name, address and  
21 occupation of the purchaser thereof, and shall be signed by the  
22 purchaser and by the person making the sale, each in the presence of  
23 the other, and shall be preserved by the vendor of such pistol or  
24 revolver for at least six years] 27 CFR 478.125. The vendor of any pistol  
25 or revolver shall make such record available for inspection upon the  
26 request of any sworn member of the Division of State Police within the  
27 Department of Public Safety or investigator assigned to the state-wide  
28 firearms trafficking task force established under section 29-38e."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
