The Committee on Human Services reported through REP. TERCYAK of the 26th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2012*) (a) The Commissioner of Social
2 Services shall conduct a study of Medicaid programs administered
3 under Title XIX of the Social Security Act. Such study shall include, but
4 not be limited to, a report on: (1) Factors the commissioner deems
5 pertinent to quality of care, and (2) whether there are any gaps in
6 access by eligible residents.

7 (b) Not later than July 1, 2013, the commissioner, in accordance with
8 section 11-4a of the general statutes, shall report the results of said
9 study to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
10 cognizance of matters relating to human services. Such report may
11 include the commissioner's recommendations for addressing identified
12 gaps in the provision of services and recommendations concerning
13 improving access to such services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
